This funding will be used to

- Ensure 100% engagement of all staff with the implementation of the behaviour and pedagogical frameworks.
- Increase school opinion survey results regarding behaviour from students, parents and staff- increase from 80% to 90%.
- Ensure 100% staff engagement with the use of the Australian Curriculum for planning and delivery of units, including planning for and implementing differentiation strategies.
- Increase proportion of students attaining the achievement standard for English across all year levels, with a particular focus on early years intervention: Year 1 students (24% in 2017- target of 15% in 2018), Year 2 students (11% in 2017- target of 5% in 2018) and Year 3 students (15% in 2017- target 12% in 2018).
- Lift the performance of our top students in English across all year levels, with a particular focus on Years 4-6 students.

Our initiatives include

Develop clear and consistent processes at Kalkie State School by:

- developing teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for curriculum planning at whole school, year level/ band and class junctures;
- providing targeted professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum;
- revisiting, refining and/or revising the school pedagogical framework of ASOT and embedding it as the shared language of teaching and learning;
- investigating, developing and implementing a framework of behaviour.
